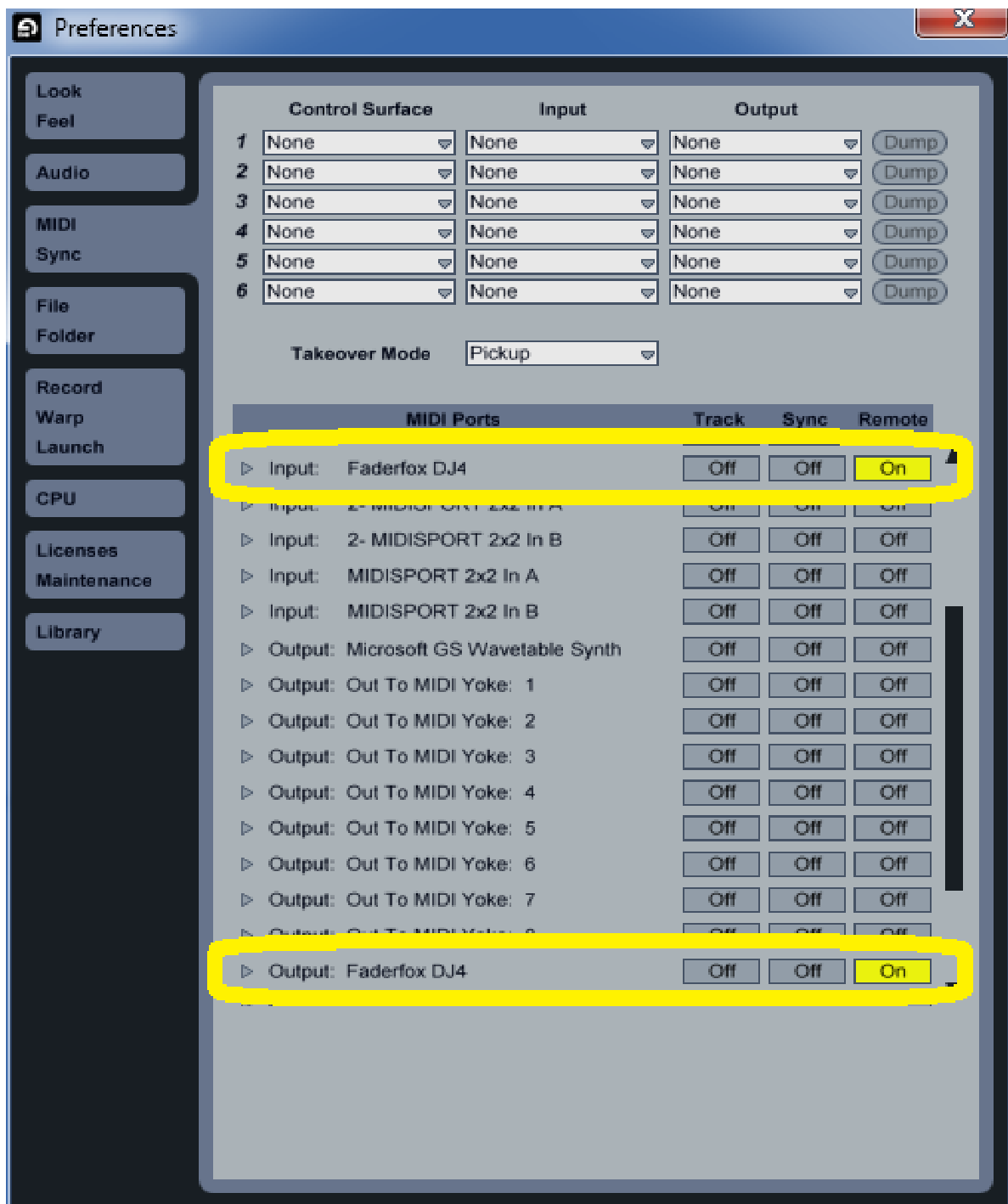
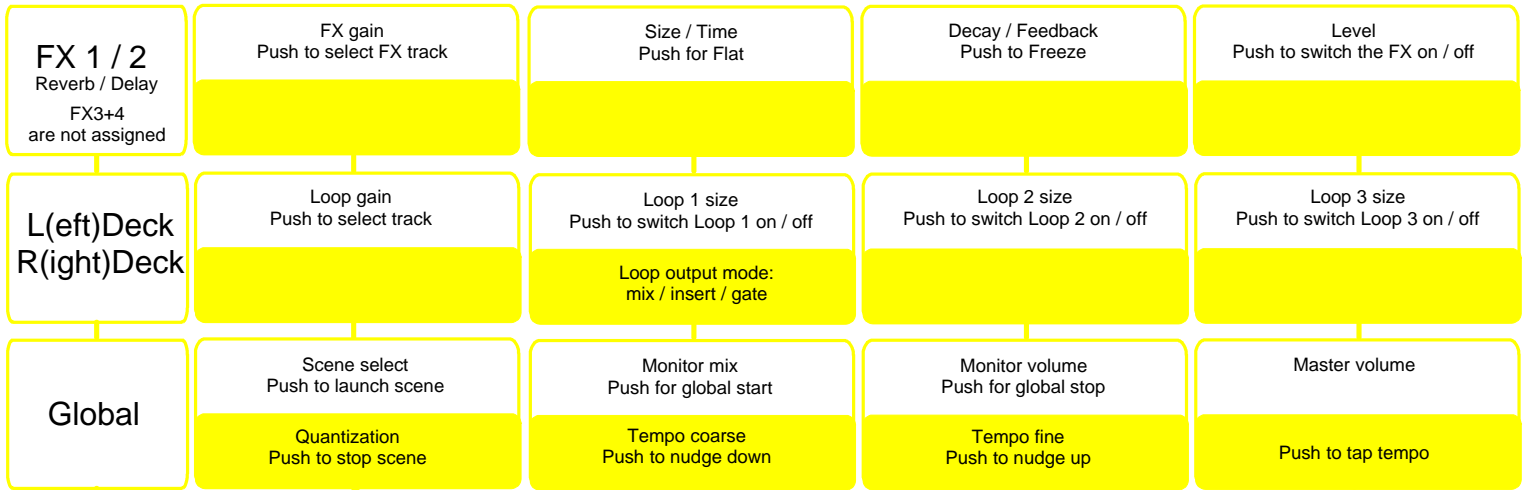


# Schnellstartanleitung DJ4 für Ableton Live

- Verbinde den DJ4 per USB mit deinem Computer (Verbindung über USB-Hub ist auch möglich)
- Starte Ableton Live Vers. 8.42 oder höher (installiere ein Update falls du eine ältere Version hast)
- Öffne Lives's Voreinstellungen und wähle den Tab 'Midi Sync'
- Aktiviere die Remote-Felder (Fernst.) in den Input- und Output-Ports 'Faderfox DJ4' (siehe Bild)
- Schließe das Preferences-Fenster (Voreinstellungen)
- Lade die Template-Datei von CD (ALS-Datei im Verzeichnis DJ4 mit allen Midi-Mappings)
- Ziehe deine Clips / Tracks in die Clip-Matrix auf Track A bis D



# DJ4 - Ableton Live setup V01



Select functions of the upper four multifunctional encoders (indicated by the 7 leds)

(Press both L.Deck & R.Deck buttons to sync deck selects and pots of controller and Traktor)

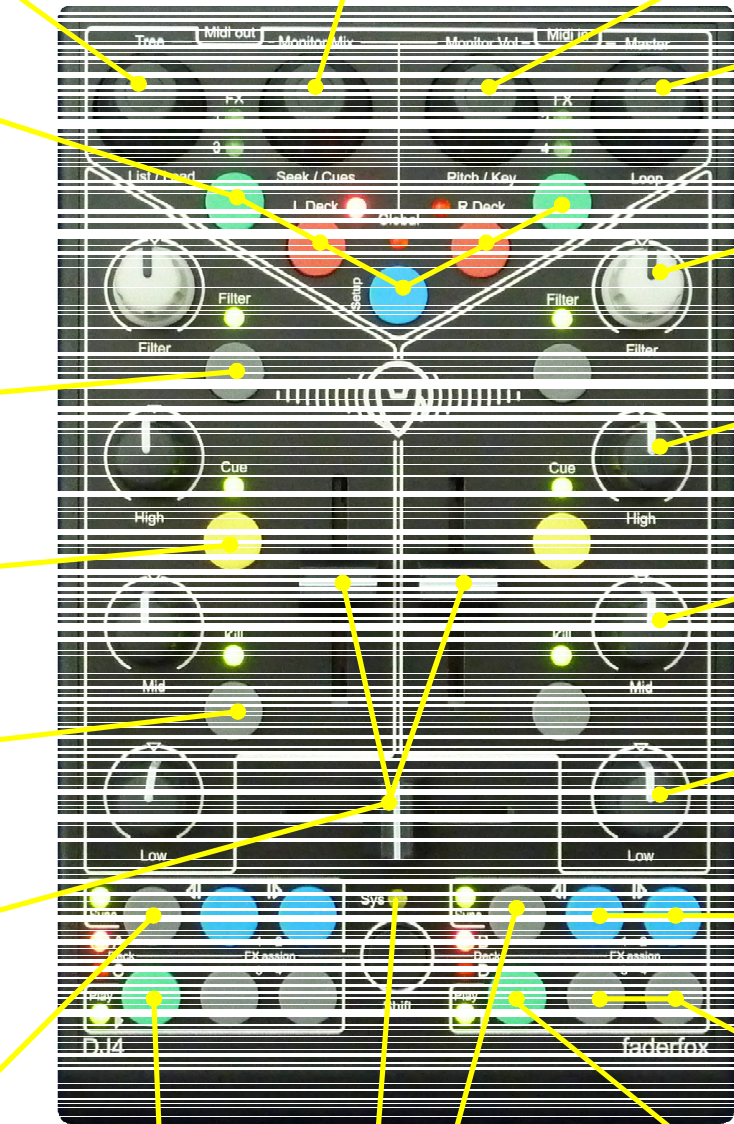

Assign deck to FX Reverb / Delay

Assign left deck controls to track C (indicated by red C led)

Track mute  
Assign right deck controls to track B (indicated by red B led)

Launch clip in highlighted scene  
Assign right deck controls to track D (indicated by red D led)

Sys led  
lit =system mode is active

**!** Hold shift button for 2nd functions written on yellow (light gray) background
